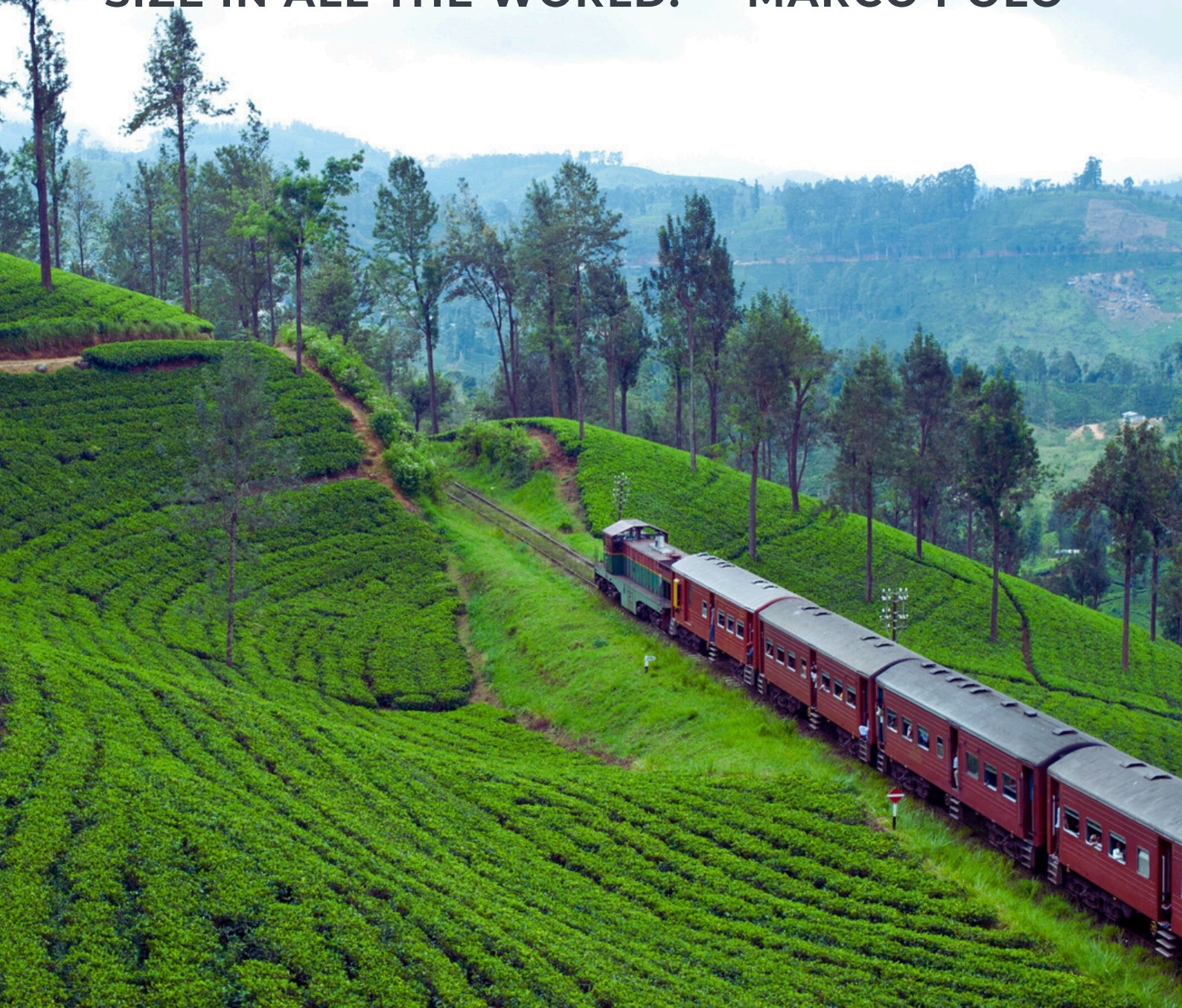

The Timeless Kingdom - Polonnaruwa

Polonnaruwa is an ancient city in Sri Lanka, renowned for its well-preserved archaeological sites and historical significance. It served as the capital of the country during the 11th and 13th centuries and is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



The Cloud Citadel - The Magnificent Rock Fortress of Sigiriya

Sigiriya, also known as the "Lion Rock," is a UNESCO World Heritage Site in Sri Lanka and one of the country's most iconic landmarks. This ancient rock fortress, built in the 5th century by King Kashyapa, rises dramatically 200 meters above the surrounding plains



The Eternal City of Light - Anuradhapura Citadel

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Anuradhapura is home to numerous historical and religious landmarks, including massive stupas like Ruwanwelisaya and Jetavanaramaya, sacred Bodhi trees, and ancient monasteries.



The Cave Temple - Dambulla

This sacred complex, dating back to the 1st century BCE, consists of five caves adorned with stunning murals and over 150 Buddha statues, along with statues of gods, goddesses, and kings.



Sacred City of the Tooth Relic - Kandy

The Temple of the Tooth Relic, locally known as Sri Dalada Maligawa, is a sacred Buddhist temple in Kandy, Sri Lanka. It houses the revered relic of the tooth of the Buddha, making it one of the most significant pilgrimage sites for Buddhists worldwide.



Into the Wild - Yala National Park

Spanning over 979 square kilometers, Yala National Park is known for its rich biodiversity, including a large population of Sri Lankan leopards, elephants, and a wide variety of birds. Yala is a popular destination for nature lovers and wildlife enthusiasts.



The Old-World Town - Galle Fort

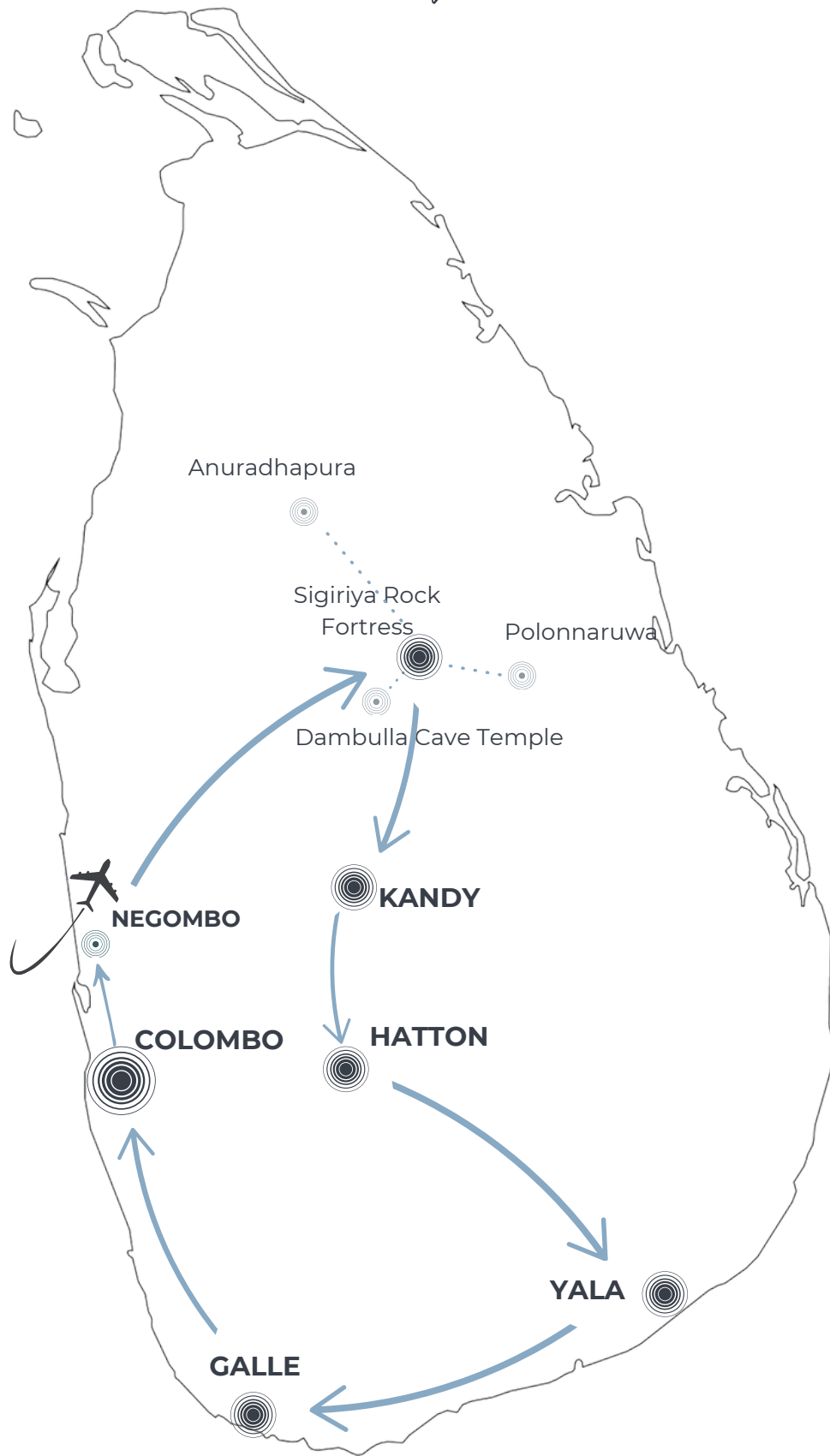
